The South Eastern Kenya University (SEKU) was established on 1st March 2013 as a fully-fledged Public University, when it was awarded a Charter, thus conforming to the enacted Universities Act No.42 of 2012. During that auspicious occasion, the University received its Accreditation Report and Instruments of Authority namely the Mace, Logo and Seal.

The University's main campus is located in Kitui County, off Machakos-Kitui Road on a 10,000 acre piece of land characterized by a beautiful undulating landscape. From Kwa Vonza centre, the university is 4.7 kilometers.

Within a very short time, the university has developed modern infrastructure making it one of the most enviable institutions of higher learning in Kenya. Some of the most notable facilities include beautiful and spacious hostels, a well stocked library, equipped computer and science laboratories,

large Lecture rooms, a state of the art guest house among others.

Programmes

There are about 6,000 students enrolled in various Bachelor's, Master's, Doctoral, Diploma and Certificate programmes in the university. The programmes are housed in the following nine (9) schools and one (1) institute.

NAIROBI CAMPUS

The Nairobi Campus was started in March 2012 in the heart of the Country's capital. It is situated at Development House, 6th Floor, South Wing, between Moi Avenue and Tom Mboya Street, in the Central Business District. The Campus has a strategic location next to the Railway Station, Bus station and the famous KENCOM *Matatu/bus* stage which are major public transport terminus, thus making

it easily accessible from all corners of the City and its environs.
